Parent Update
Confirmed Wider Reopening w/c 15th June

Dear Parents & Carers,

As we shared with you yesterday, following advice from the Director of Public Health for Doncaster, we will begin a stepped wider opening of our academy next week. From Monday, 15th June, all Y6 pupils will be given the opportunity to take up the offer to return to school for an initial allocation of **2 days per week**. The sessions will run from **8.45a.m to 2.30p.m**;

-Monday, 15th June & Tuesday, 16th June

or

-Thursday, 18th & Friday, 19th June

In the first instance, for next week, we have offered the Monday/Tuesday provision to those parents who have previously declared their intention to take a place by submitting the form sent out prior to half-term (dated 13/05/2020). These parents have already been contacted today via Schoolcomms to confirm places.

For the Thursday / Friday Y6 provision next week, **if it is your intention to take up a place**, please complete and return the attached form via email to info@morleyplace.org.uk by midday **Tuesday, 16th June**. An editable version of the form will also be emailed out today, or you may take a picture/screenshot of the completed form and attach to your return email.

Please note that the academy will continue to be open to provide emergency childcare for vulnerable pupils and the children of key workers Monday to Friday as required, from 8.30a.m to 2.50p.m- please ensure that you have notified us of the days you require. **If you are a key worker and your child has not yet required a place, you may also complete and submit the attached form as per the instruction above.**

An additional guidance document will also be sent out today, which outlines all of the measures that we have taken as an academy to ensure that both the site itself and our procedures are as safe as possible for all of our pupils and staff. It also details arrangements for drop off & pick up each day, as well as an addendum to our behaviour policy, which explains the additional expectations/procedures during this time. Please read through this carefully with your child in preparation for them returning to school. This document will also be shared with children whilst attending the academy.

A quick reminder also for those attending the childcare or taking up the offer of Y6 provision- please can we request that all children not receiving free-school meals, use Parentpay to purchase their daily lunch. These are priced at £2.20 per day. This is in line with the Covid-19 risk assessments, as pupils are currently unable to bring any items from home, including food onto site.

Following the confirmed take-up of vulnerable / key worker and Y6 places next week, we will review if any additional provision can be provided and notify you by letter.

Our thanks once again for your patience, support and understanding. It is very much appreciated during these difficult times.

Please continue to get in touch with us should you have any issues or queries. We look forward to beginning to welcome more of our children back into school next week!
